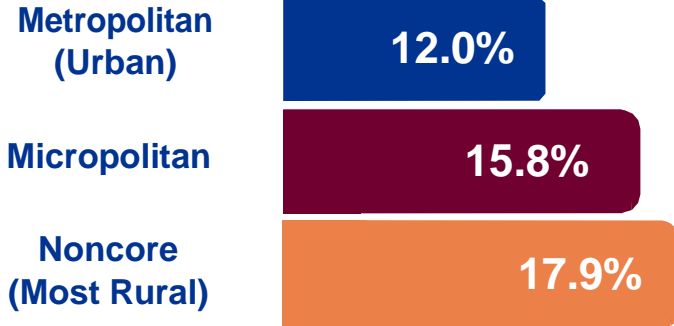


2018 U.S. RURAL DISABILITY STATISTICS

In more rural places, disparities widen.

DISABILITY PREVALENCE



3,194,377 people with disabilities live in the most rural places, where the prevalence of disability is highest.

POVERTY RATE

1 in 4 people with disabilities in the most **rural** places experience poverty...



compared to only 1 in 5 in the most **urban** places.



DEFINING PLACE

Urban Counties

Metropolitan: with urban core of 50,000+

Rural Counties

Micropolitan: with urban core of 10,000-50,000

Noncore: with no urban core (less than 10,000)

In more rural places, people with disabilities report:



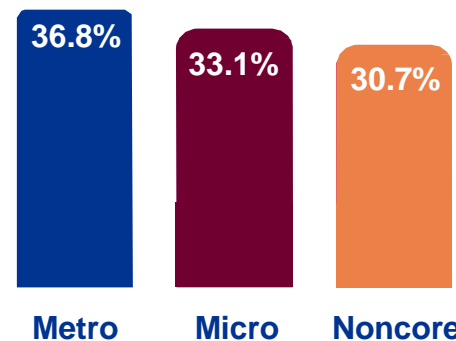
lower rates of private insurance
